MILWAUKEE PUG FEST is the "**LARGEST PUG EVENT IN NORTH AMERICA**" Open to all Pug, Pug Mixes and "Smoochie-Faced" breeds. People come from Canada and from all over the U.S. The "Big Event" is held at the **Milwaukee County Indoor Sports Complex, 6000 W. Ryan Road; Franklin, WI 53132**, a 55,000 sq. ft. indoor complex that we fill with vendors, Rescues, approximately 3,800-plus humans and over 2,100 Pugs, Pug Mixes and "Smoochie-Faced" Breeds.

Services onsite include a pet photography by In Focus Photography; nail trimming by Madra Pet Styling; and animal communicator Robin Williamson. There will be demonstrations and contests. The contests include three categories of the Costume contest. The three categories are "Hand-crafted", "Ready-made" and "Strollers & Floats". Fr. John Allen will perform the "Blessing of the Pugs" which includes a general blessing and individualized blessings. There is also a Pug Race which medals and prizes are awarded to the top three winners.

Pug Fest also has the "PUGFEST STORE" selling event merchandise, a 400 Item-plus Silent Auction, 70-plus vendors.....AND MORE!
